To Applicants

- 1. Rooms for writing examinations and waiting rooms (meeting places) for oral examinations are indicated on the following pages.
- 2. You are permitted to enter the building and room for writing examinations from9:00 am. Show your Reference Card whenever you enter the building.
- 3. Make sure you keep your Reference Card with you throughout the examinations. If you have lost your Reference Card, report it to the head office of the examination venue. (1A203, 1A Building)
- 4. Take your seat in the examination room 15 minutes prior to the start of each subject examination. Turn off any alarms on your digital devices (mobile phone, smartphone, smartwatch, smart glasses, etc.) and switch them off. Put it in your bag before entering the room.
- 5. Examination rooms do not have clocks. Bring your own watch or clock. A mobile phone, smartphone, etc., as a clock is not permitted.
- 6. Examinees who arrive late will be permitted to take the examination only when such lateness is within 30 minutes of the start of the examination. If such lateness was caused by an unavoidable reason such as a transportation accident, report to the head office of the examination venue and ask for instruction.
- 7. You are not permitted to exit the room before the end of the examination.
- 8. If you feel unwell, please notify the proctor and follow the instruction.
- 9. Follow any other instructions given by the proctor.

Be sure to get to the venue in time instructed from the degree programs. Be careful that the venue and time might be different for each examinee. [Notice] You are not permitted to check the venue for the entrance examination before the examinations.
